The Rachel Stornant Junior Artist Scholarship Competition (RSJAC) is held in memory of our beloved friend and colleague, Rachel, who left us too far too soon. In her final year with us, Rachel taught a young student free of charge in order to assist her in upgrading to a new flute. We believe Rachel's final wish would have been to help promote the careers of young, budding talent in the Southeast Michigan flute community.

Eligibility: The RSJAC is open to any Michigan resident who has not yet completed the 8th grade as of the date of the final round of the competition (October 6, 2018) The RSJAC Applicants must be active SEMFA members and submit an additional application fee of \$20.00. Student Membership dues of \$15.00 are non-refundable and may be mailed with the application. The membership year runs from January 1, to December 31. Previous winners of the RSJAC are ineligible to compete.

Application: All applications must include a completed application form, a written essay, a letter of recommendation from private flute teacher, and necessary dues and fees. **No recording is required.** All applications must be received (email preferred) no later than September 22, 2018. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Applicants will be informed of their status by September 29, 2018. Checks should be made payable to SEMFA (Southeast Michigan Flute Association).

Requirements:

- Students must submit an essay of no more than 300 words about their musical goals and how they will use the scholarship money (winners must provide SEMFA with a receipt demonstrating that the money was used for musical purposes).
- Students must submit a brief (100 – 120 word) biography written in the third person.
- Students must submit 1 letter of teacher recommendation.
- Students must be available to perform live at the final round of the competition on October 6, 2018, at 8:00am, during the SEMFA Fall Festival

- Up to 12 applicants will be selected for the live performance round.
- Students must submit a repertoire list of one selection from "Forty Little Pieces" edited by Louis Moyse (Schirmer) as well as one piece of the applicant's choice to be performed at the final round of the competition. The total length of both works should not exceed 10 minutes. Individual movements from larger works are permitted. Cuts will be permitted.

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- Works including piano must be performed with accompaniment.
- SEMFA would like to recommend all applicants use Doug Scott as an accompanist for this competition. His information will be available on the website and will also be sent when finalists have been selected.
- Memorization is encouraged but not required.
- The membership year begins January 1, and runs through December 31. Membership fee must be paid for current year.

Awards:

1st Place will receive a \$300 Scholarship.

2nd Place will receive a \$200 scholarship.

3rd Place will receive a \$100 Scholarship.

Three Honorable Mentions will also be awarded
